**IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING
THE FRANKLIN COUNTY TRAFFIC
CODE BY ADOPTING PROVISIONS
PERTAINING TO COMMERCIAL
MOTOR VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, Section 304.130 RSMO empowers Franklin County, as a first class county, to establish by order traffic regulations, including regulations pertaining to commercial motor vehicles, within the unincorporated portions of Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission has adopted a traffic code and schedules pertaining to public roadways in the unincorporated portions of Franklin County, Missouri, establishing the penalty for violation thereof and the procedure to be followed through the County Municipal Court established pursuant to Section 67.320 RSMo., for the prosecution thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of Franklin County to adopt code provisions regulating the use and operation of commercial motor vehicles within Franklin County and to amend the Franklin County Municipal Traffic Code pertaining thereto.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, by the County Commission of Franklin County that the Franklin County Traffic Code be and is hereby amended by adding thereto Sections FC 302.727, FC 304.170, FC 304.172, FC 304-174, FC 304.180, FC 304.181, FC 304.240, and FC 307.400, copies of which are attached hereto, to be effective the earlier of either January 1, 2018 or at such time as the Franklin County Sheriff's Department has personnel trained regarding commercial vehicle violations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Debbie Door, Clerk of the County Commission, provide a copy of this Order to Laurie Ruether, Clerk of the Municipal Court; Joe Purschke, Municipal Court Prosecutor; Steven Pelton, Franklin County Sheriff; Ron Williams, Highway Administrator and Mark Vincent, County Counselor.
